


SDP Online Survey Results







Please share any other thoughts you may have about our SDP:

1 Response:

"Some of the jargon in the plan seems abstract. e.g. What does "authentic personalization / differentiation" mean? Maybe I'm looking at it through a simplified lens but it seems that literacy would improve if students were held accountable for completing more reading and writing outside school hours. I'm not saying they should be given hours of homework but 30 minutes a day would not be a big ask. When I ask my daughters to put down their phones and read a book, they come up with excuses to not do so. They say, "we read at school". I think a better use of school time would be focused on instruction. They can read at home and it would be easier for parents to make that happen if they were held accountable by teachers for writing a book report or essay on their reading. On another note, I noticed that the percentages do not add up in the data presented. e.g. Under, "Reads to explore, construct & extend understanding" the percent of students achieving each indicator from 1-4 adds up to 50.2%. Are there no results for 48.8% of the students?"

3 Responses:

"The field trips are important to learning. I've noted that some grades go on a lot of trips, yet my child has only had one so far this year - the Be Brave hockey game. I wonder if it could be a bit more even with every grade going on at least 2 trips or even max of 3 trips. I'm not sure of the number, but the experiences of going on an field trip should be extended to all students"

"Increase school fees, if needed. They are currently very reasonable."

"It does seem that fees have increased in the last couple years. I understand why this is happening and I feel that the provincial government is being let off the hook a little bit. The funding has effectively dropped but I don't think most parents and citizens know that. I think it would be worthwhile for the CBE to come up with some way to make the funding situation easier to understand and more transparent for parents. Is there some way to present a very simplified budget that illustrates this for parents. Something parents could consume in 20 seconds that gives them the overall picture?"
