Principal's Report - Andrea

Budgeting/Staffing Update

- RAM Sept 30 count below projected enrollment (~20 fewer students), affected staffing
- Final fall RAM has been issued as of Nov 18 we are at 28% of our reference point (3 student withdrawals after Sept 30 count =\$15,000 approx)
- Big budget eaters:
 - Unpaid student fees approx. \$11,000
 - Operational costs (e.g., learning resources, staff development, supplies for paper & copies, etc.)
- Budget helpers
 - RRPA Wish List support through fundraising
 - School-based fundraising (e.g., Education Matters, winter wreaths)

Staffing changes

- Dreanne White (office assistant) has accepted a new position
- New hire Sarah Fatima (15 hrs office assistant, 10 hr lunch supervisor)
- Continue to search for permanent lunch supervision staff
- Alana Swereda (K, Gr 1/2) maternity leave, started this past Monday
 - o Arianna Lovas will be filling the KD position
 - o Lindsay Bliek will be taking the Gr 1/2 position full-time

School Improvements

- New doors installed (basement classrooms)
- Door removed (bathroom hallway)
- Landscaping rocks installed

Furniture Purchase Update

- Learning commons and middle school classroom order is on its way
- Removed initial request for rolling chairs due to cost, now able to increase soft seating in Learning Commons
- Ordering little mobile booths and soft poofs for flexible seating

- Keeping old chairs
- Education Matters donation (~\$1800) by two anonymous RPS families reallocating government family grant money during the strike
