Rideau Park – a close-knit community school!



- Established in 1930, serving Rideau Park, Roxboro, Parkhill, Cliff Bungalow, Mission

- K – 9 student population (approx 50/50 between K-6 and 7-9), serving 440 students
- Sport Court, Playground, Gaga Ball, Fields, Natural Garden

Registration and Lottery Considerations



- Rideau Park is a school 'In Lottery'
- Schools must run a lottery when they receive more registrations than the available space for a program

Wait List - if not offered placement, the student is added to our priority Wait List.

- When space is available, parents are called to offer placement

- Registration Deadline for Lottery:

- February 10 at noon**

- To be included in the lottery, an online registration must be received by the deadline above



Typical Day in Kindergarten



Getting Ready for Kindergarten



Build your child's independence:

- dress themselves (zippers, buttons)
- use the bathroom and wash their hands on their own
- put away toys and help out in other small ways at home
- practice opening and closing snack containers and using a water bottle
- play games, take turns and compromise
- develop a consistent bedtime routine



Getting Ready for Kindergarten



Literacy:


- read stories together in *your first language* to help your child develop vocabulary, listening and speaking skills
- enjoy reading different types of books: picture books, information books, nursery rhymes, poetry
- encourage your child to talk about the pictures and stories as you read together
- visit your community library (when possible)

Getting Ready for Kindergarten



Explore communication:

- share special activities together, such as walks to the park
- talk about what you are seeing and doing
- talk, read, sing and play in *your first language* every day
- praise children for their efforts and courage to overcome setbacks
- talk about how it is okay to make mistakes
