Spring '24/'25 & Celebrations

- Dates posted on the school website
- Grade 5s going on Grade 6 Calaway Park trip due to split classes
- Grade 9 Celebration - June 5 & 25
 - Staff have been invited
 - Charging \$55/person (\$4400), usually need about \$7000, which covers the basics (e.g., venue, medallions), does not include decorations
 - Request for money for decorations from Parent Council (vs funding available from principal)

- Can use funds from No Child Left Behind
 - 80 students in grade 9
 - Travis - do we need to look at other options for Grade 9 celebration in future years?
